Lovingly restored, this turn-key wedding venue and bed & breakfast, offering 3 bedrooms and 4.5 bathrooms, is a seamless blend of history and hospitality. The grand 4,188 sq ft event venue and charming 1,253 sq ft caretaker's cottage are filled with timeless elegance. Antique chandeliers cast a warm glow over original heart pine floors, while intricate wrought iron furniture, fine china, and period antiques create an atmosphere steeped in nostalgia. Sunlight filters through poured glass windows, illuminating the custom drapery and heirloom details that make every corner a tribute to the past.

The venue's carefully curated spaces offer both intimacy and grandeur. The Iris Room and Bluebird Room, original to the home, provide cozy retreats for guests, while The Bell Suite, added in the 1970s, offers versatility as a luxurious suite or an elegant dining area for up to 60 guests.

Step outside into a setting reminiscent of a Southern garden party—brick-lined pathways wind through lush landscaping, guiding guests to the fountain garden, pool house, and the fire pit garden, where a charming stage invites music under the stars. Towering magnolias, cherry trees, azaleas, and a stately ginkgo tree, over a century old, complete the picture of timeless beauty.

Seamlessly blending history with modern convenience, the home is equipped with WiFi-controlled doors, video monitoring, and a fully appointed caterer's kitchen designed for large-scale entertaining. A 1958 Magic Chef gas oven with six burners, two ovens, a griddle, and a broiler anchors the space, complemented by pristine enameled metal cabinets, stainless countertops, and modern appliances—including a dishwasher, refrigerator, microwave, and coffee maker—all of which remain with the property. Just off The Bell Suite, a wet bar and coffee station add to the venue's charm, while a full-scale laundry and a three-station sink provide a commercial kitchen requirement.

The more modern caretaker's cottage offers additional living space with a cozy living room, modern kitchen, and an upstairs master suite with three closets and a private bath. A two-car garage completes this functional addition to the property.

The current owner purchased The Bell House with a vision—one that took shape through a meticulous three-year renovation, restoring the property to its full grandeur while crafting an exclusive Event Venue and Bed & Breakfast business model. Every detail, from the elegant interiors to the seamless event operations, has been thoughtfully designed to create an exceptional guest experience.

Due to the owner's primary full-time job, the venue has only operated at a fraction of its potential, maintaining a booking rate capped at 30%. With a dedicated, full-time operator at the helm, this property is poised to reach a 90% booking capacity, generating an estimated \$30K-\$50K in monthly revenue. The business is already in motion—events are scheduled, all furnishings and supplies are in place, and the foundation for success has been built. Now, all it needs is the right owner to take it to the next level.

From the first step onto its charming grounds to the final toast under its twinkling lights, The Bell House is a place where memories are made, love is celebrated, and history is honored. With a reputation for warmth and elegance, this turnkey venue is ready for its next chapter. - All fireplaces are coal burning except for the dining room; gas lines are present but capped
- Six exterior doors: front door, back patio door, guest door (leads to parking lot), two doors off the Bell Suite, and storage room door off the Billiard Room (considered a service door)

Sunroom

Laundry Room

- A hand wash sink, 3-station sink and mop sink (required for a commercial food service kitchen)
- Exterior door leading to the parking lot is flanked by laundry room and wet bar

Parking Lot Garden Veranda

- Located between the Parking Lot and the entrance next to the Wet Bar (Guest Entrance).
- Restored arch trellises Arches originally from the Atlanta Botanical Gardens, used for roses and jasmine
- Original gas-powered City of Griffin Street light was completely restored and converted to LED lighting.
- Wonderful area for an after-hours wine tasting, coffee area or live music.

Bell Suite

- → His and Hers full bathrooms with closets and custom built-ins in each closet. There are large mirrors at the end of the hall of each bathroom
- → Hallway has 2 additional storage closets with show racks. Currently linens and towels.
- Antique chandeliers (2), added by owner, in hallway leading to the Bell Suite







- Two separate glass doors flanking a large bay window lead to the gardens
- ◆ Bedroom size is 30'X40'
- ❖ The Bell Suite is also used for an event setup of up to 50-60 people.
- ◆ Fandelier (chandelier and fan combination), added by owner
- Plantation panel-style shutters, custom made for all windows
- Original hardwood floors
- FUN FACT: Prior to cable television, there were rabbit ears for TV service. There is a large antenna up in the attic that takes up the entire attic space above the Bell Suite

Linens and Towels

- The linens, towels and table linens are all of very high quality, for a 1st class hotel experience. They are the same style of high quality linens and towels used at Hyatt hotels. They are made by '1888 Mills', which makes all of Hyatt hotels linens/towels. They were all acquired in 2018.
- ➡ Bed Linens: Each bedroom has 4 complete sets of bed linens, 6-8 pillows to include mattress covers, duvets, duvet covers, pillow liners etc.
- ◆ Table Linens: There are ~15 sets of white linen table cloths for folding tables, 50 sets of napkins.
- Towels: ~50 sets of bath towels, washcloths, hand towels and bath mats, all of very high quality similar to a Hyatt hotel.
- ⋄ High quality blankets and comforters

Tables and Chairs

An inventory of tables and chairs for 50-60 people. Several 6' folding tables with white resin folding chairs with seats. Chairs are stored on rolling dollies

- ♣ Fully restored wrought iron patio furniture and 2 loungers with cushions.
