



Location


The Bear Creek Valley Ranch is located 42 miles south of Missoula, on the west side of the Bitterroot Valley. Missoula is easily accessible via major highways, with Interstate 90 running east to west through the valley and Montana Highway 93 running north to south. From Missoula, travel 34 miles south on MT Highway 93, then head west for 6 miles to reach the property. Hamilton is situated 20 miles further south, boasts a charming downtown filled with small-town character and appeal.

Hamilton Airport is publicly owned and features a paved 5,200-foot runway capable of accommodating most jets. The airport offers transportation services and jet fuel, and it serves as a key gateway to the Bitterroot Valley's backcountry. It is also one of the busiest general aviation airports in Montana.

Missoula International Airport (MSO), located to the north, is served by several major U.S. airlines, providing both year-round and seasonal flights to a variety of destinations.


The Bitterroot Valley is often referred to as Montana's "banana belt" due to its favorable climate, with mild winters and pleasant summers. The Bitterroot and Sapphire Mountains run parallel to the valley and river, offering breathtaking scenery with dramatic peaks and expansive views.





Opportunity

Bear Creek Valley Ranch spans 140 deeded acres across six parcels, following Bear Creek for nearly a mile along its southern boundary. The property is easily navigable, featuring scenic trails that meander beside the roaring creek and through a timbered forest. This wooded landscape opens into a peaceful meadow that serves as a natural wildlife habitat. Nestled within this tranquil setting are three homes and two shops, offering both comfort and functionality in a stunning natural environment.



Buildings

Located at the heart of the property are three brick homes, construction started in 1987. Spanning 3,024 square feet, each residence includes three bedrooms, two bathrooms, and a two-car garage. These homes were constructed with exceptional attention to energy efficiency and craftsmanship. In addition, the property features two separate garages and workshop spaces, offering added room for storage and projects.







Recreation

This forested ranch, threaded with clear-running creeks, supports an exceptional variety of wildlife. Elk, moose, whitetail, and mule deer move freely through the timber, while black bear, mountain lion, and fox add to the area's wild character. Game birds, songbirds, and raptors like hawks and owls thrive in this rich, diverse habitat. A true sanctuary for both big game and birdlife.

A property of this caliber offers more than just land—it provides a sense of place, privacy, and connection to the natural world. Whether you're seeking a retreat, a base for adventure, or a lasting legacy, this ranch stands ready to deliver an unmatched Montana experience.

Bear Creek supports predominately rainbow trout and lower numbers of brown trout and brook trout in the lower stream and west slope cutthroat trout in the upper basin mixed with very low densities of juvenile bull trout.














Taxes and Water Rights







