Dear Mr. Holland:

Your initial 10 year deferment period (2006 - 2015) from the Johnson County Wastewater Capital Charge has expired.

On October 21, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. WD 10-035, which allows an additional 10 year deferment for properties of five acres or less used as a single family residence, providing the property continues to meet all of the original eligibility requirements.

We have reviewed your property's status and found that it still meets the original deferment eligibility requirements. This property has been granted an additional 10 year deferment from the Capital Charge for Johnson County Wastewater. This deferment extension will be effective starting with the 2016 tax year for a period of 10 years.

The deferment period is conditional and shall be terminated at such time as any of the following conditions apply:

- 1. The property's classification is changed to a use other than a single family residence.
- 2. Structure(s) on the property are connected to the sanitary sewerage facilities of the Wastewater Districts.
- 3. The property is subdivided after the started date of the deferment.
- 4. The property owner signs a petition for creation or enlargement of a sanitary sewer district in which this property is included.
