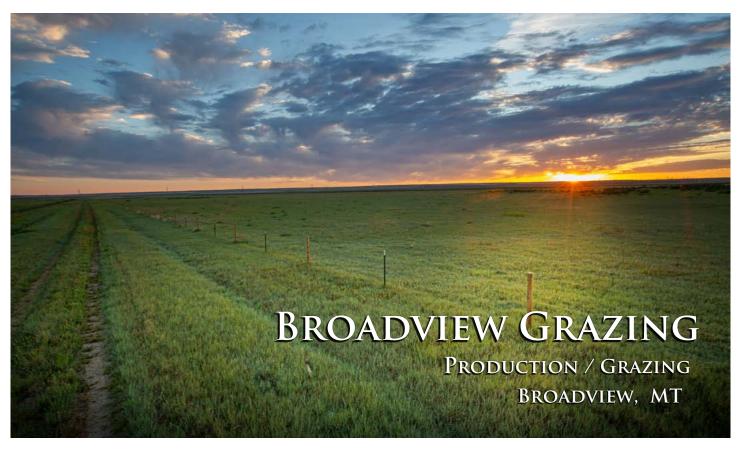

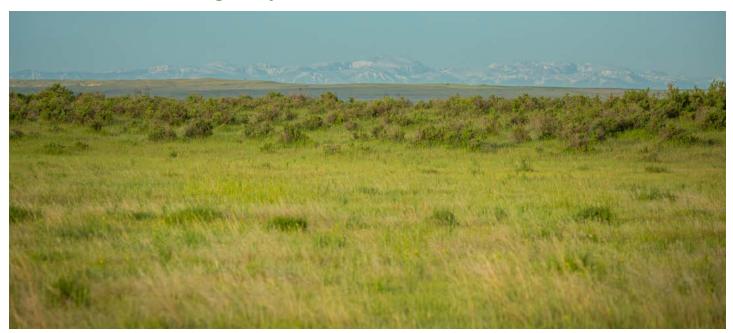

DESCRIPTION: This Efficient 640-acre Grazing Parcel lies just 10-miles SE of Broadview and-20 miles NW of Billings, MT. With nutrient-rich Hard Grass, it offers excellent grazing for Cattle and Livestock. The property is fully perimeter fenced with old county road access. A reliable Solar-Powered Well and Seasonal Reservoirs support Livestock needs. On favorable years, portions may also be Hayed & Pastured later in the season. There is some potential to Cultivate a portion of the land for those interested in Farming. Upland Game Birds and Pronghorn Antelope frequent the area, offering added value for Hunting and Wildlife Viewing & Enjoyment.

ACREAGE: Broadview Grazing is comprised of a total of 640.46 +/- Deeded Acres



LOCATION: The entirety of Broadview Grazing lies within Yellowstone County, located approximately 20-miles Northwest of **Billings**, Montana's largest city, and 10-miles Southeast of **Broadview**, **MT.** Accessible just 2-miles North of MT Hwy-3 on David Road. The first mile of David Road is well maintained gravel road, the Second mile of David Road, North of Berkley Rd. is non-maintained dirt.



PRODUCTION: Historically, this property has been leased or directly opperated and handled between 40-70 Animal Units for Summer Pasture, Mid-May – October, depending on Moisture and Grazing Practices. This Large Pasture of mixed Native Grasses with no Pine Trees, would make a great addition for a Larger Cow/Calf Operation, or could also make an excellent Yearling outfit. For a Standalone for a Smaller Operation Supplemental feeding requirements may vary on the winter conditions and Hay is typically fed in the area from Dec to the end of April.

WATER: Broadview Grazing Parcel has a total of (1) water right associated with the Parcel. Livestock water is provided by (1) Active Solar Well, (1) Storage Tank, (3) Livestock Tanks, and Multiple Natural Seasonal Reservoirs. The current Facilities for Livestock/Wildlife Water provide a base supply of water for the needs of the Parcel as it is operated, but additional water could be developed if so desired.

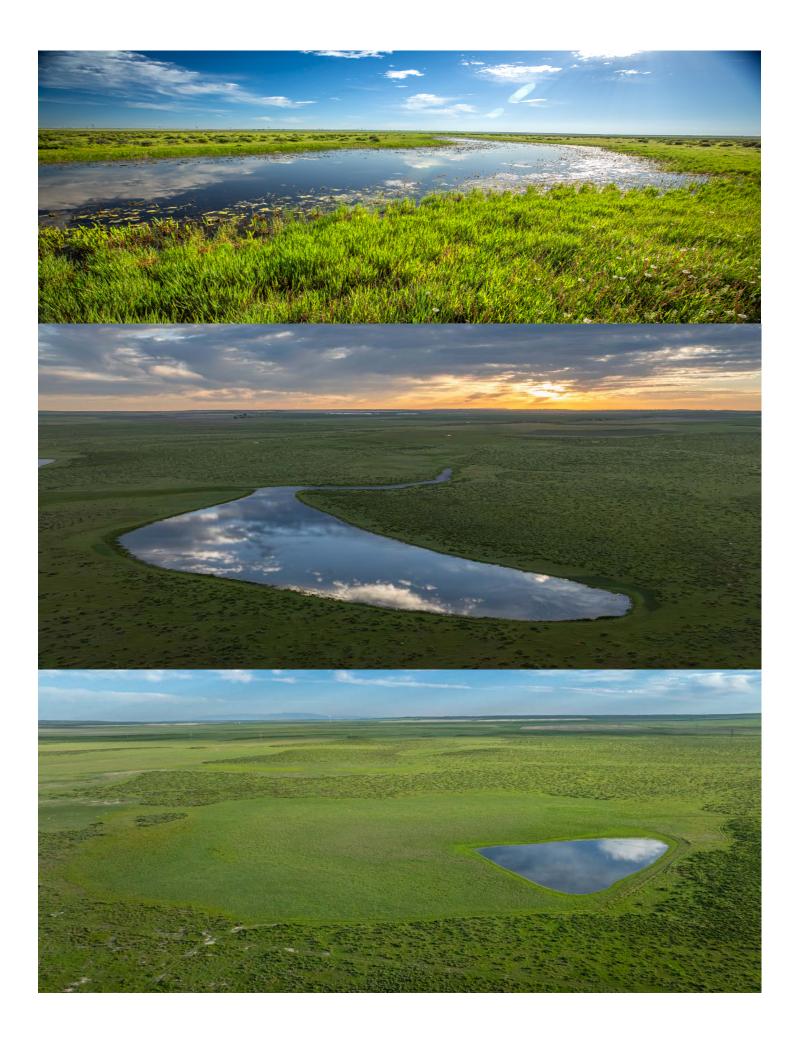

WILDLIFE / HUNTING / RECREATION: Though hunting opportunities are low on this property, Antelope and a few Mule Deer are seen on the property from time to time. The Ranch lies within the Elk/Deer/Lion District 590 and Antelope District 576. Sharp-tailed Grouse make use of the Upland Habitat, while Ducks and Canadian Geese also make a few visits to the Seasonal Reservoirs, giving additional opportunities for the Outdoorsman and Wildlife Viewing. A small Prairie Dog Town also provides additional Recreation.





The Deeded Acres of the Ranch may offer limited Hunting and Recreational opportunities within its Borders, but the Ranch has approximately 25,000 +/- additional acres of other State, BLM and Block Management Access, within 15 miles, providing plenty of additional Hunting/Recreational access and opportunity just moments away.

LOCATION & SERVICES:

Broadview, MT (population 139) – approx. 10 miles (13-minutes)

Broadview is a quiet little town that Features a Gas Station, Auto Repair Shop, Grain Elevator, Bar & Grill, and Class "C" Broadview K-12 School.

Billings, MT (population 109,577) – approx. 20 miles (20-minutes)

Billings is the largest City in Montana and offers extensive services, has (2) major hospitals, as well as a wide variety of shops, restaurants, breweries, museums, a zoo, major theaters (8) golf courses and event centers bringing in top performers.

Billings Logan International Airport (BIL), the largest commercial airport in Montana, is located only 87 miles from the Resort. It offers services from multiple major airlines and direct flights to many larger cities including Dallas, Denver, Minneapolis, Las Vegas, Portland, Salt Lake City, Seattle, and Phoenix. Roundup, MT (population 1,850) – approx. 48 Miles (53 min)

The County Seat of Musselshell County offers many amenities and lies 5 miles to the West on Hwy-12. It is home to multiple Restaurants, (2) Grocery Stores, (2) Gas Stations, a Hardware Store, an Implement Dealer, Bars, Churches, and Class "B" Roundup High School.

"Pine Ridge Golf Course" is a well-designed and challenging 9-hole course and just across the road is the Roundup Sportsman's Association Shooting Range. The Roundup Sportsman's Range has an Archery Range that winds its way through a coulee, a Trap area for shotguns, a 25-yard range for sight-in and rim-fire, a handgun range and 100 & 200-yard rifle range.

CLIMATE: With an average Elevation of approximately 3,750 feet, the Broadview area has a semi-arid climate with Average Precipitation of 14 +/- inches and an average of 36-inches of snow each winter. Historically the warmest month of the year is July with an average daily high/low of 86°/53°. The coldest month is January with an average high/low of 34°/11°.

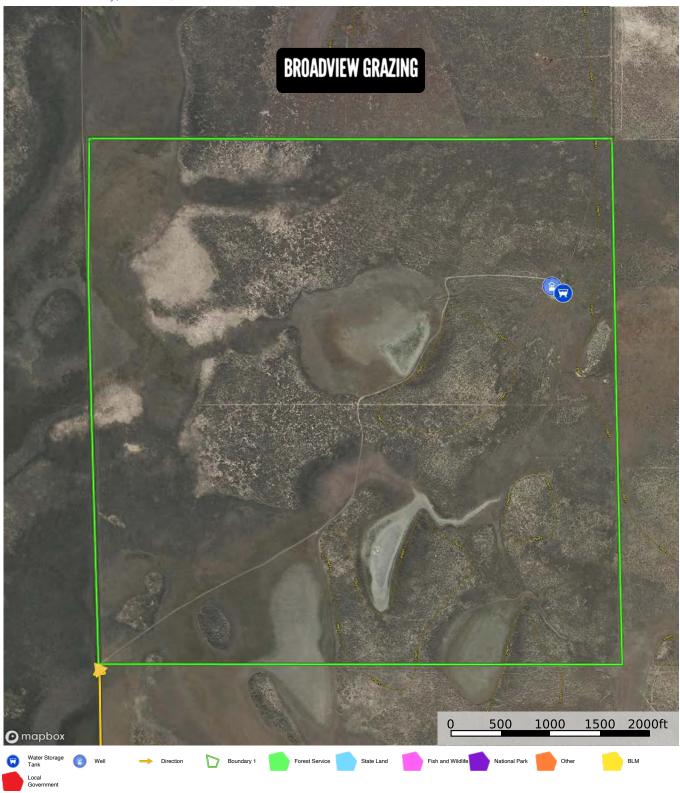
