

The Broken Wheel Ranch spans 550± acres of varied and functional terrain. You'll find a thoughtful blend of open pasture, cleared mesquite flats, and pockets of native hardwoods like oak and hackberry. Years of strategic clearing have opened up the land, improved accessibility, and allowed native grasses to thrive. With multiple water sources, cross fencing, and a maintained road system, the property is well-suited for grazing, hunting, recreation, and future improvements.








MAPS
