

## The Camellia House At The Historic Hall House, Circa 1911 1105 North Sycamore Street

1105 North Sycamore Street Palestine, Texas

The historic neighborhood north of the city's central business district contains a large percentage of houses that date from the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. This 1-story frame dwelling is a well-preserved example. It is classified as a modified L-plan house and displays Queen Anne stylistic features, including a wrap around front porch.. The property retains a significant amount of its integrity. The earliest known owners of this house were C. Roe Hall and his wife Harriett. Mr. Hall had a "farming office" in the Link Building downtown.
