- **Drilling a private well** Costs vary but typically range from \$5,000–\$15,000 depending on depth and contractor.
- **Cistern system** Large tanks filled by water delivery or rainwater collection.
- Water hauling Available locally, often used with a 1,000–2,500 gallon tank.

☐ Good to know: The land is in a well-drained area, not in a flood zone, and suitable for installing any of these systems.

2. Power Supply &

Costilla County is a popular place for solar setups thanks to its sunny climate.

Off-grid power options include:

- Solar panels with battery storage Quiet, efficient, and sustainable.
- **Generators** Often used as backup power.
- Wind turbines Less common, but possible depending on location.



☐ **Tip:** Many landowners start small with a portable solar system, then scale up as needed.

3. Waste & Septic Systems &

There's no public sewage, so waste management is handled privately — and the county provides clear guidelines.

Popular options:

- **Septic system** Standard for cabins and permanent homes. Requires a permit and professional installation.
- Composting toilets Great for RVs or eco-conscious setups.
- Holding tanks Often used temporarily during construction or RV stays.

Bonus: Community & Access

Although these properties feel remote, they're located **near other developed parcels**, making setup easier and giving you a sense of community — without losing your privacy.
