The water right, application, and claim information provided on the "Map Search Results" page(s) is taken from WRTS. Although the Water Resources Program takes great pains to ensure that the data entered is correct, there may be data entry errors. The reproduction of the documents in image format is in many cases available and that information takes precedence over the tabular data found on the "Map Search Results" page(s).

Keying the information into the databases also impacts accuracy. We have tried to maintain a high level of accuracy when keying in the data, but cleaning projects continue today.

Some loss of information can occur from scanning a document. Small dots that end abbreviated words or decimals that separate whole numbers from fractions can be lost as a result of scanning. If a number has a gap between its digits or if the line that boxes it has white space where a continuous line should be, then any associated numeric value should be scrutinized. REPORT

Background

On January 19, 1982 Richard E. Ormiston of Prosser, Washington filed an application to appropriate public groundwaters in the amount of 300 gallons per minute (gpm) for single domestic supply, supplemental irrigation supply and frost protection. The application was accepted and assigned No. G4-27008. Public notice of the applicant's intent was given pursuant to RCW 90.03.280. The 30-day protest period concluded on March 13, 1982.

On February 10, 1982 an objection to this application was received from Mr. W.D. Williams.

Investigation

On November 10, 1983 the undersigned conducted a field examination of this application. The site was inspected with Mr. Ormiston present.

The place of use is on the south flank of Rattlesnake Ridge about 7 miles north of Prosser. The parcel in question is planted in orchard and has irrigation water from the Roza Irrigation District. The Roza Irrigation District operation map, revised February 1983, shows Mr. Ormiston to receive delivery to 88.3 acres. He has requested water for 80 acres. There is one residence on the property which is supplied water from the applicant's well through a cistern. Additionally, the domestic water supply is used to fill spray rigs.

Based upon the many years of operation of the Yakima Project, it is clear that a generally reliable supply of irrigation water is provided by the six divisions of the project. During the 1979 and 1980 water years there were occurrences of limited water supply combined with structural maintenance to the Lake Cle Elum outlet works and delivery system failures which created unprecedented shortfalls in the water delivery of the divisions of the Yakima Project with proratable rights. During 1979, the Roza Irrigation District patrons received water deliveries which averaged 0.8 acre-feet per acre less than the average delivery for the 1959-1973 period. This annual quantity of water is sufficient to provide an adequate supplemental supply.

At 0.8 acre-feet per acre, 64 acre-feet would suffice for the supplemental irrigation of 80 acres.

Since irrigation water is already provided, domestic supply should be allowed at 1 acre-foot, an additional .5 acre-foot is allowed for spray water within the domestic allocation.

Frost protection is allocated on the basis of twelve (12) eight hour periods. Over this period 300 gpm yields 5.4 acre-feet of frost protection.

The applicant's water well construction report shows that two basalt flows have been penetrated. The upper basalt flow from 4 to 10 feet is the Elephant Mountain Basalt. The second lower basalt flow is the Pomona Basalt (142-300 feet). The major water producing zone in the well is from the base of the Pomona Basalt between 298 and 300 feet. A PVC liner from the surface to 204 feet maintains the integrity of the well bore through the upper water bearing zone at approximately 180 feet.

Consideration of Objection

Mr. Williams is concerned about the proximity of Mr. Ormiston's well to his. About 1000 feet separates these wells. Additionally, Mr. Williams is concerned about the possibility of the Ormiston well taking water from the "upper water bearing zone". Mr. Williams considers his own well to be obtaining water from this upper zone. Additional information on the construction of Mr. William's well was requested on November 23, 1983 but none has been made available and there are no records on file with this office.

A worst case situation can be simulated based on pumping information from the Ormiston well. The following parameters were used to calculate possible drawdown in the Williams well. This simulation presumes that both wells draw from the same aquifer. Pumping the Ormiston well at a continuous rate of 300 gpm for 58 days (the least time necessary to pump 70.9 acre-feet of water) in an aquifer with a transmissibility of 11,300 (based on a pump test of the Ormiston well at 300 gpm). This simulation produces a drawdown of just less than 13 feet at the Williams well.

The area in question has a stable water level. The water level on November 11, 1983 was 183 feet. During the Ormiston pumping test of May 27, 1980 the initial water level was also reportedly 183 feet. There has been essentially no water level change in 3½ years.

Conclusions

1. Prior water rights will not be adversely affected.
2. Water is available for this use.
3. Continuous domestic supply, supplemental irrigation supply and frost protection are beneficial uses and granting the requested permit would not be contrary to the public interest.

Recommendations

Based on the previous discussion I recommend that the following quantities be allowed: 300 gpm, 1.5 acre-foot for continuous domestic supply; 5.4 acre-feet for frost protection as required; and 64 acre-feet for supplemental irrigation.

The irrigation water herein authorized to be withdrawn is a supplemental right, with the water made available under primary rights by the Roza Irrigation District; thence, the only water herein permitted for withdrawal is that required to compensate for any deficit in this supply. This amount shall not exceed 8 acre-feet per year per acre.

All water wells constructed within the state shall meet the minimum standards for construction and maintenance as provided under RCW 18.104 (Washington Water Well Construction Act of 1971) and Chapter 173-160 WAC (Minimum Standards for Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells).

Installation and maintenance of an access port as described in Ground Water Bulletin No. 1 is required. An air line and gage may be installed in addition to the access port.

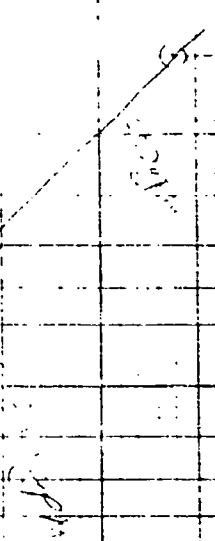

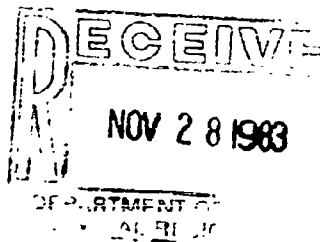

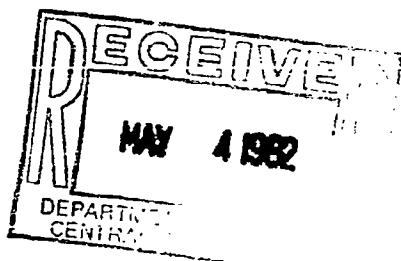

Dear Mr. Crowe:

You were licensed with the State of Washington during the period, June 27, 1974 through June 27, 1978.

Docket Order, DE 78-377, dated August 21, 1978, was issued to you reminding you of your failure to renew your license No. 0090 on schedule. You were afforded time until August 31, 1978, to renew your license or allow it to lapse. You made no attempt to renew in the allotted time, as a result your license was revoked on August 31, 1978.

On March 17, 1982, I received a telephone call from Elaine Peterson of the Central Regional Office stating that you had drilled a well recently and had failed to submit a well report which was needed to fulfill a permit requirement. This would indicate that you were in fact, in violation of the Licensing Laws contained in WAC 173-162.

You will immediately cease and desist from further construction of water wells in the State of Washington on a permanent basis, or qualify for a new license by retaking the water well drillers' examination.

In the meantime, you are required to submit a well report on the illegal well you drilled.

I urge you to take the above action voluntarily for I shall have no further recourse but to refer this matter to the Attorney General for prosecution.

at about 180 ft. but he did not think it
would be adequate volume. Therefore,
I allowed him to continue drilling thru
some more hard basalt rock. At about
290 ft. he became quite pleased at the
amount of water and thought it increased
for several more feet. At approximately
300 ft. he was in hard basalt rock, so
I had him discontinue at 305 ft.

At this time I engaged Basin Pump Service of Kennewick to run a test.

The test report shows that at a pump setting of 284 ft; the draw down was 20' over a 4 hour period at 300 gals. per minute.

This was the maximum capacity of the testing equipment.

In 1980 we installed a 1/2 H.P. Submersible pump for domestic use.

In 1981, due to the prospects of the Roza Irrigation Dist. being short of water, and the fact that I had planted the entire place to apple trees, I decided to install a 30 H.P. Submersible pump which would supply about 300 G.P.M. free discharge or 275 G.P.M. running sprinklers at 20 lb. pressure and installed a reservoir with a small jet pump for domestic use.

At this time and several times prior to this I asked Mr. Willard for a well log. I had hoped to get this before applying for a permit.

I now have received notice from your office that on 2/23/82 a Mr. Bill Williams, who lives south of this property, is protesting my Well Permit # E4-27868 as he claims it is the same strata (or aquifer) as his domestic well.

I say this is not true! Before I ever started to drill a well, I had a visit

~~was~~ with Mr Williams at which time he told me his well was 180 ft and a good domestic well.

I do not believe that my well is in the first aquifer as he states in his letter of protest.

Please advise me as to the next move I should make to obtain the permit I need and to clear up this matter.
