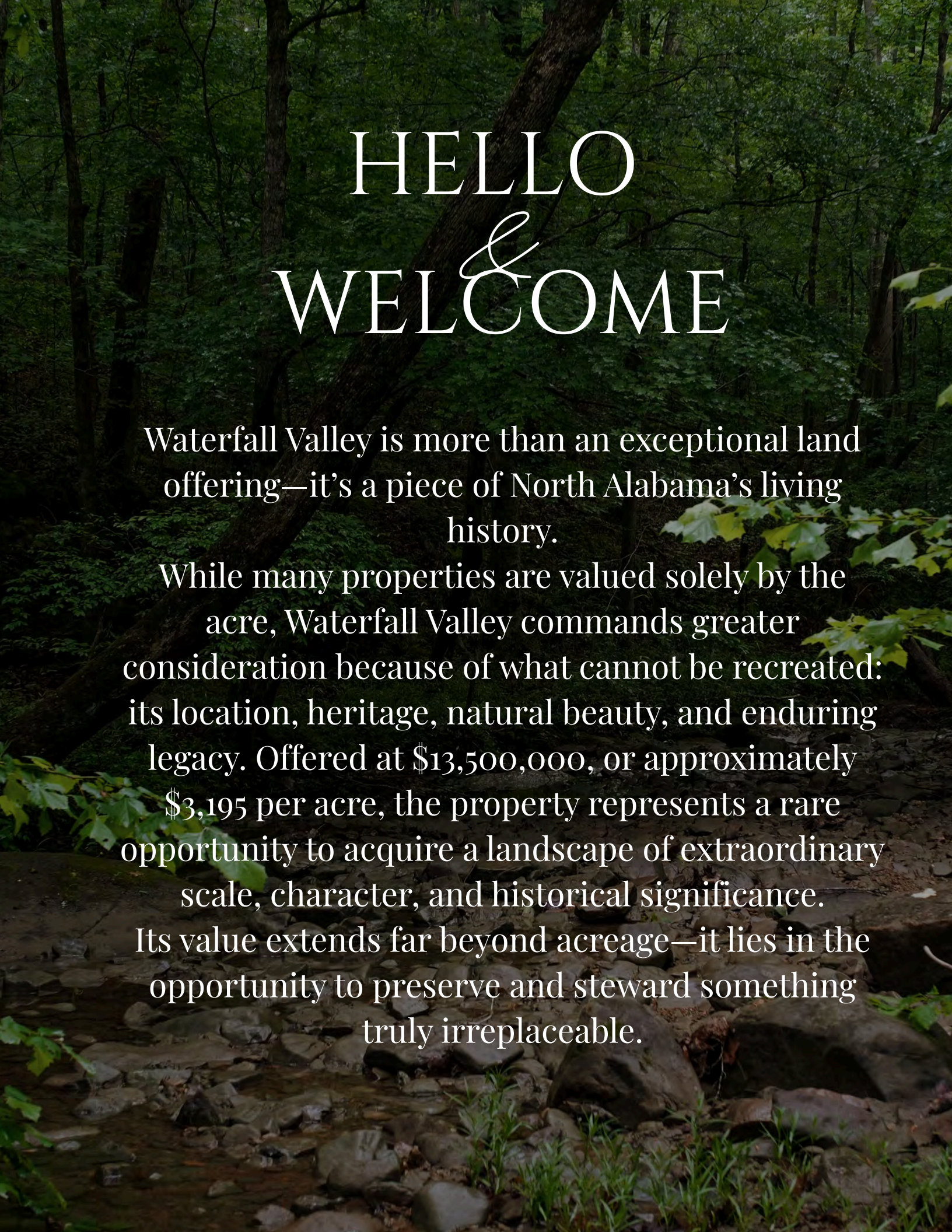

Waterfall Valley is more than an exceptional land offering—it's a piece of North Alabama's living history.

While many properties are valued solely by the acre, Waterfall Valley commands greater consideration because of what cannot be recreated: its location, heritage, natural beauty, and enduring legacy. Offered at \$13,500,000, or approximately \$3,195 per acre, the property represents a rare opportunity to acquire a landscape of extraordinary scale, character, and historical significance. Its value extends far beyond acreage—it lies in the opportunity to preserve and steward something truly irreplaceable.

LOCATION

Situated in Colbert County, Waterfall Valley is a rare, large-acreage property offering dramatic natural landscape features, rich ecological diversity, and substantial long-term timber value. Ranging from shaded creek ravines and sheltered hollows up to panoramic ridges reaching over 900 feet, this contiguous forest represents a true legacy property, perfect for a private hunting retreat, high-yield timber management, or preserving a piece of North Alabama's natural beauty for generations.



THE PROPERTY

Rare large acreage, contiguous property: Waterfall Valley totals 4,225 acres. Roughly 56% of the property lies on broad ridges that have been in active forest management for almost 60 years. The rest of the acres lie quietly below the high walls that rim the ridgetops. These highwalls are unusual in that they form an almost continuous barrier around the valley. That's not to say that the Valley is inaccessible; there are several access roads that safely get you in and out, but the limited access has meant that the valley has been relatively untouched for generations. Timber activity stays up top, and the Valley with all of its geology, history, diversity and beauty just ... is.



THE PROPERTY

Minutes from the Shoals:

This property is located only 15-20 minutes from the Shoals Area, specifically 30 minutes from the Northwest Alabama Regional Airport. Four cities comprise the Shoals with Sheffield, Tuscumbia and Muscle Shoals on the southern banks of the Tennessee River, and Florence on the north.

Together these cities have a population of 79,000, and themselves are an hour's drive from Huntsville.



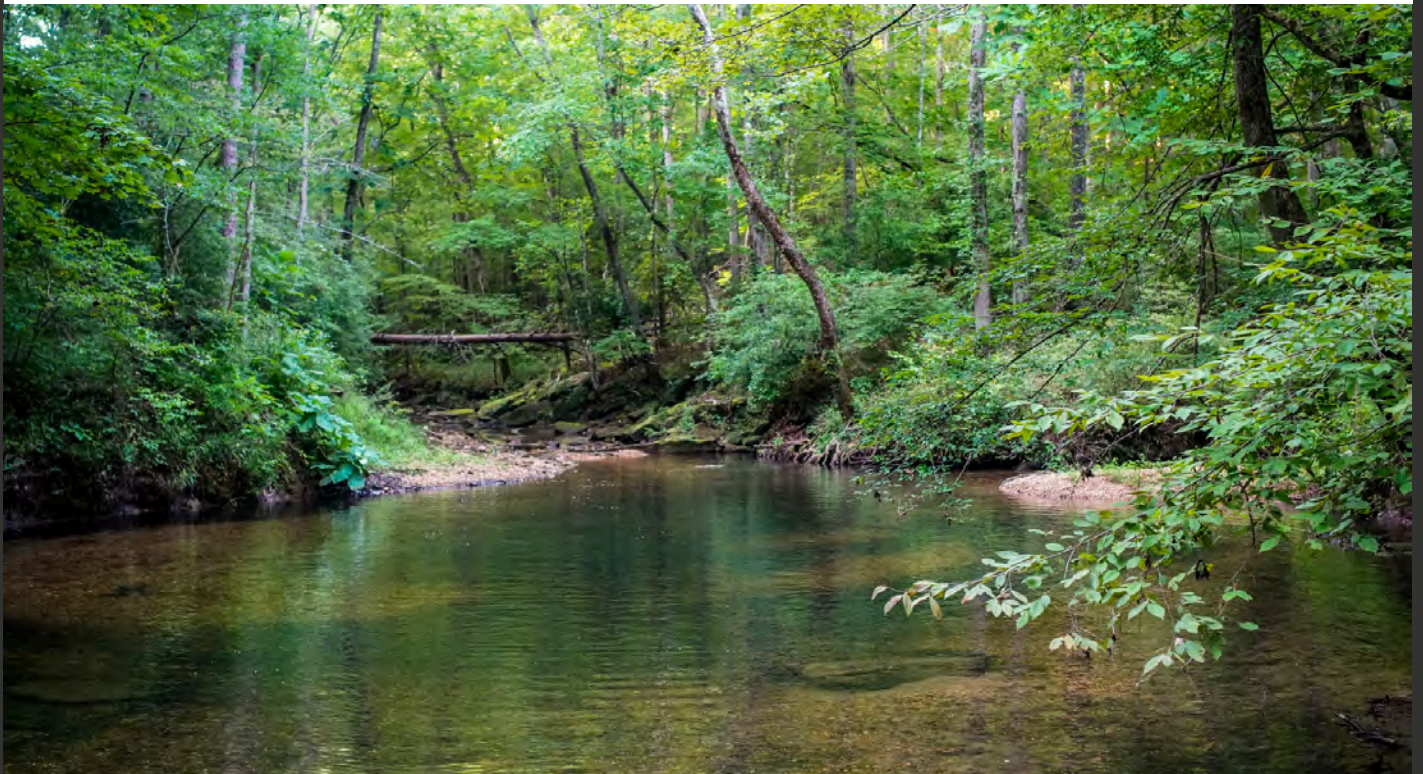

Alabama landscape.



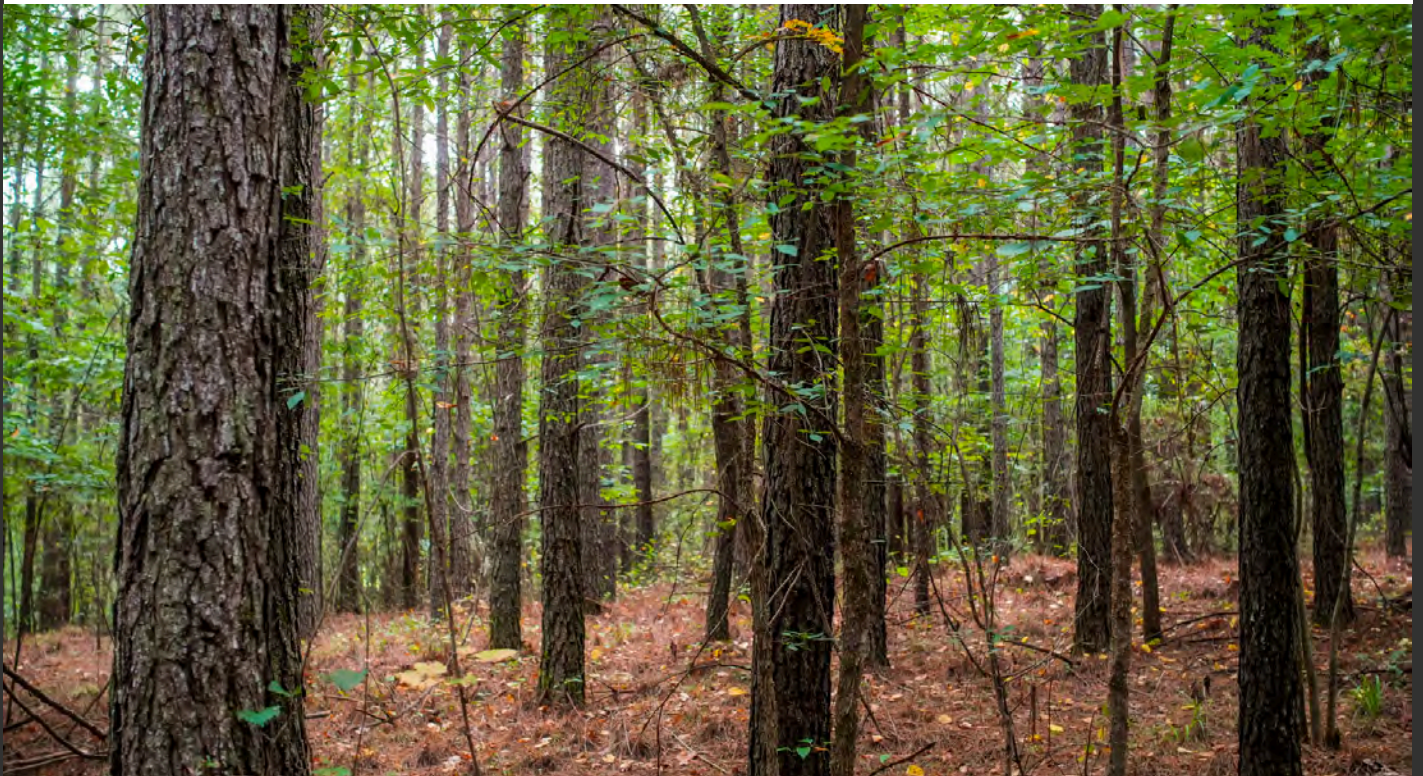

Exceptional Habitat & Wildlife: The combination of rugged ridges, sheltered hollows, and fresh water creates rich natural cover and active travel corridors, offering a premier habitat for white-tailed deer and wild turkey, alongside a thriving ecosystem for songbirds, native amphibians, and local wildlife.

Turnkey Hunting Lease:

A well-respected hunting club has leased the hunting rights for over 62 years and have been excellent stewards of the land, maintaining food plots and roads and alerting the landowners on the rare occasion when something might need their attention. The lease can be terminated or assumed by the new owner.





TIMBER ASSETS & FOREST COMPOSITION

Waterfall Valley features a diverse timber portfolio spanning mature hardwoods, established pine plantations, actively managed stands, and young planted pine. The range of stand ages and forest types provides both current timber value and long-term growth potential.

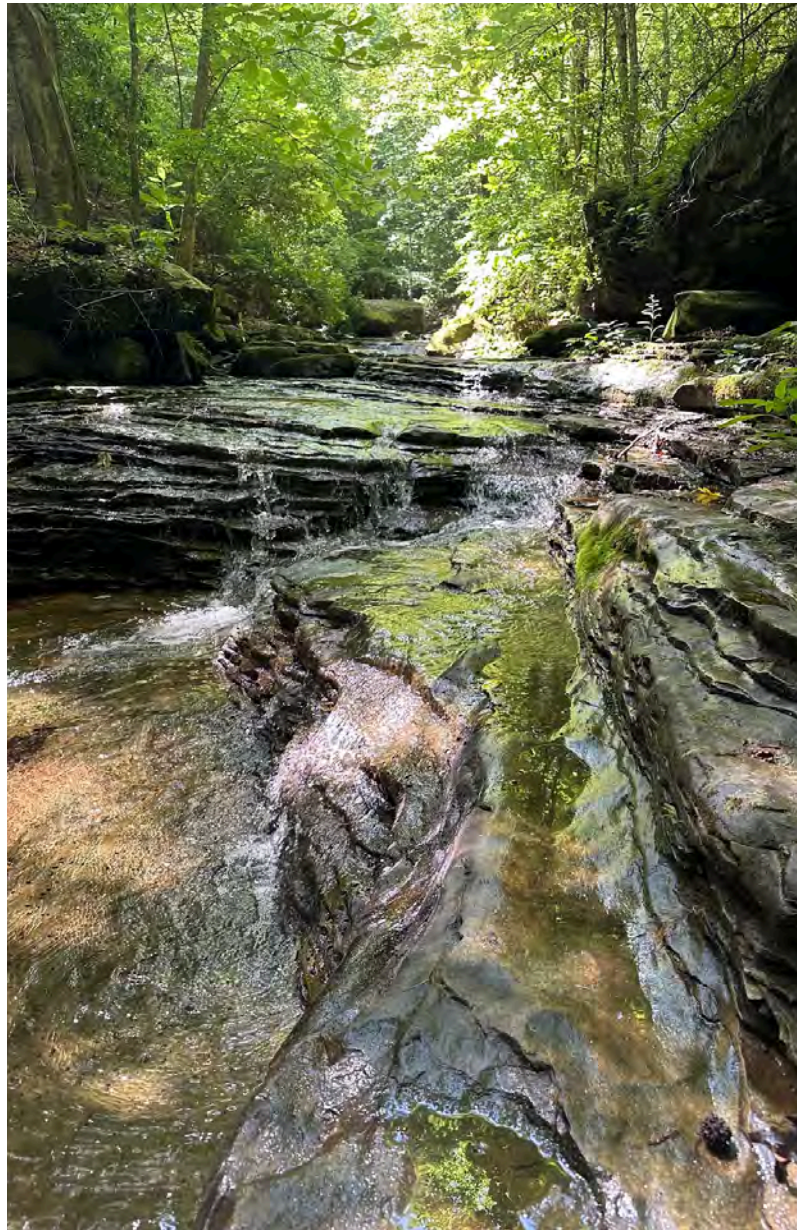
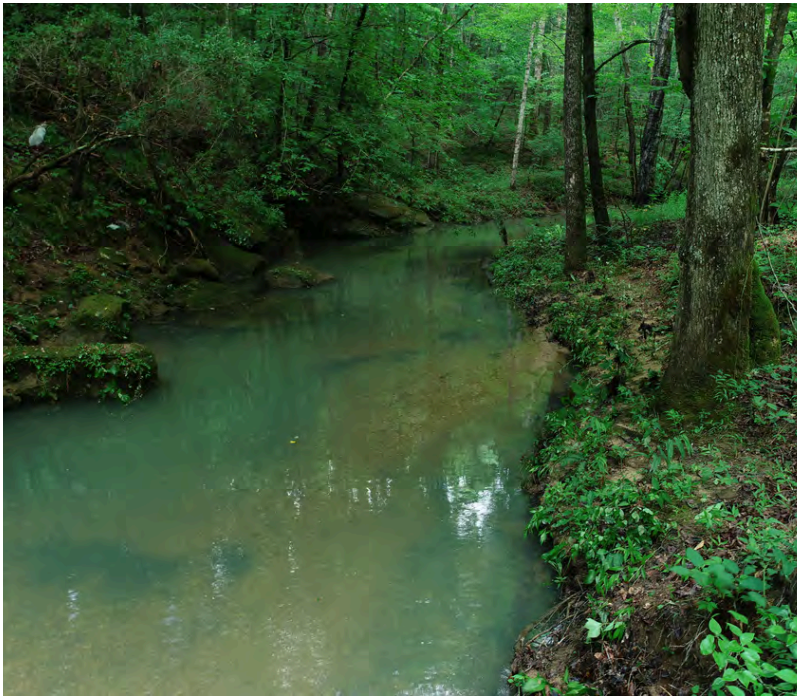
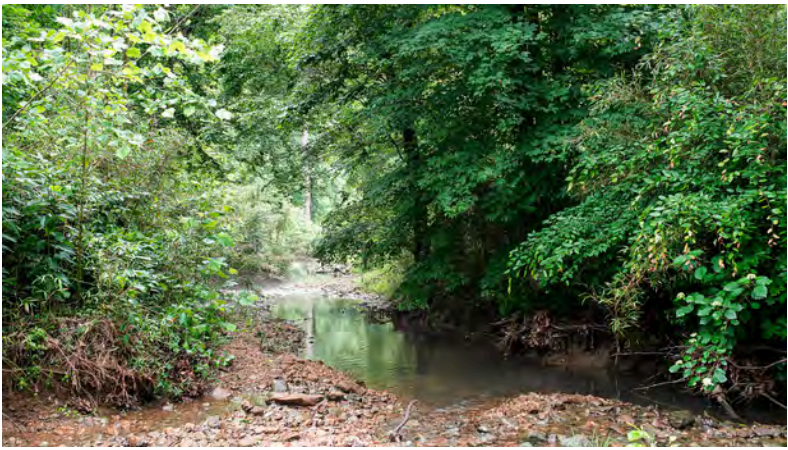
